III. Fundraisers

The multiple fundraiser payments and tickets are due 9-16 and pick up is on 10-03. The profits will be divided 50/50 between the Boosters and individual students. We can sell at Kailua

Hardware on 9-27 and 2 dates in November. We could sell the snack packs and beef sticks.

Homecoming is on 9-25 and we have received approval from Ramona to sell items. Wendell will bring his tent and set it up like last year. Kim will pick up dry ice for the ice cream and we'll use the freezer again. Items that were suggested to sell were: popcorn (Nick's mom can get a popcorn machine), snack packs, beef sticks, water (after the stand closes) and candy (from Costco).

(After the meeting we found out we could sell ice cream, snack packs and beef sticks but not popcorn, water or candy.)

Matson clean-up is scheduled for Sunday, 10-25 at Sherwood Forest in Waimanalo. The committee meets on 9-9-09 and we'll know 2-3 days after the meeting. Matson promised to have the container there. A person needs to be there on Monday to empty and sweep out the container. The band will earn \$1000.

The silent auction will be held with the steak dinner on Sunday, 11-08. People are needed to help with getting donations.
